Emergency Policy

In the event of a medical emergency, our protocol is as follows:

- **SERIOUS MEDICAL SITUATION, BUT NOT IMMEDIATELY LIFE-THREATENING**
 - In the event of a serious medical situation (104 degree fever or higher, allergic reaction, continuous vomiting, etc), staff will apply first aid techniques to manage the situation.
 - Parents are immediately called using the contact numbers provided. This is both to inform the parents of the situation, but also to receive any additional relevant information as well as instruction.
 - If Parents cannot be contacted within a reasonable time period, staff will call 911 for emergency services.
 - **If you receive a phone call or text from any Argo Navis staff member, please respond immediately.*

- **LIFE-THREATENING MEDICAL EMERGENCY**
 - In the event of a life-threatening emergency (choking, trouble breathing, severe bleeding, etc), staff will call 911 immediately for medical assistance.
 - If necessary, staff will apply life-saving techniques including CPR or other First Aid techniques to manage the situation until professional medical attention can be applied.
 - Parents are notified after 911 has been called.

In the event of any emergency, Argo Navis staff reserves the right to contact medical professionals on behalf of any child in their care. The safety and well-being of children in our care is our number one priority; and though we are considerate of any potential financial hardship that may be incurred through the use of professional medical services, we will not fail to be immediate and deliberate in our response to a medical emergency.
